



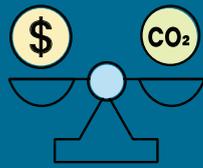

2022 data highlights



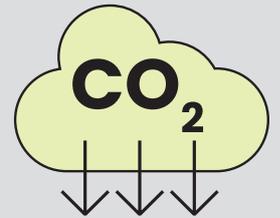
23 million

ACCUs were transacted in the secondary market in 2022, more than triple that of 2021.



1.5 million

ACCUs have been cancelled in 2022 for voluntary or state and territory compliance purposes.



2022 saw a record **17.7 million** ACCUs issued, surpassing the **17 million** ACCUs issued in 2021.

4.3 GW

additional renewable energy capacity reached Final Investment Decision (FID) in 2022.



Following the release of the Independent review of ACCUs and draft Safeguard Mechanism reforms in January 2023, the generic ACCU spot price hit a 9-month high of **\$39**.



2.5 GW

of new capacity was approved for LGC creation in 2022.



2.8 GW

of small-scale solar PV capacity was installed in 2022, the third highest annual capacity installed on record.
